New Library Books Galore!

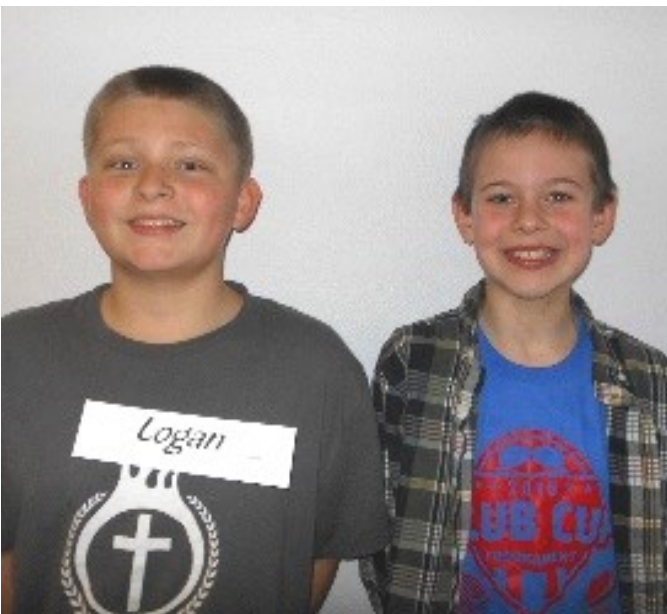

Do you have a child who will be age five by August 31? Save the date for Clarkston's Kindergarten registration, taking place April 6 to May 2.

Kindergarten registration in Clarkston for the 2016-2017 school year will take place from 9 AM to 3 PM each day at Parkway. To register a child, parents **MUST** bring the child's birth certificate and immunization record.

During registration, parents will make an appointment for the Kindergarten Round-Up. The Round-Up lasts from May 3rd to the 6th at the District Office.
